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

SUBJECT: **HEARING OF FEBRUARY 2, 2024; TESTIMONY IN SUPPORT OF
HB1778, RELATING TO TOBACCO PRODUCTS**

Thank you for the opportunity to testify in **support** of this important measure. The measure's purposes are to prohibit the sale of flavored tobacco products and mislabeled e-liquid products that contain nicotine and to repeal language making the sale of tobacco and electronic smoking devices a statewide concern and preempting county ordinances and regulations.

The Maui County Council has not had the opportunity to take a formal position on this measure. Therefore, I am providing this testimony in my capacity as an individual member of the Maui County Council.

I **support** this measure for the following reasons:

1. This measure would allow counties to prohibit retailers from displaying, marketing, or selling flavored tobacco or nicotine products, which often have a far greater nicotine content than cigarettes.
2. It would allow communities to maintain drug-free educational environments where flavored nicotine vape products, which are often targeted to youth consumers, are prohibited.
3. This measure would also help reduce the physical- and mental-health impacts caused by long-term use of flavored tobacco and nicotine products.

For the foregoing reasons, I **support** this measure.

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
